DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Situated on the north side of West Salisbury Street facing south is a two story frame house with a finished third floor attic under a slate covered mansard roof. It has three bays, one over one sash, flat top architraves, bevel topped siding, a dormer, and a porch extending across the front. This building was constructed early in the last quarter of the 19th century.


