DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Situated on the north side of West Salisbury Street facing south is a two story, asymmetrical, brick residence. It has an off center projecting cross gable extending to the south. All stretcher bond brickwork forms the walls. The windows have segmentally arched heads with one over one double hung sash. A one story porch covers the front of the cross gable and extends around to the east side. This building was constructed in the first quarter of the 20th century.


