This double house, situated on the east side of South Conococheague Street, facing west is a two story, six bay double residence of frame construction. It would appear to date from the mid to late 19th century and is covered with asbestos shingle siding. Windows have two over two pane double hung sashes. Two entrances are located side by side in the two central bays. The roof is covered with asphalt shingles and brick chimneys are located inside the end walls.
