Situated on the southwest corner of East Potomac Street and North Artizan Street is an amalgamated series of buildings most of which are a full two stories in height being used for commercial purposes. There is a modern white brick veneer over probably a frame structure. Most of the windows are two over two double hung sash. The roof is composition shingle. This series of buildings under one roof was built in the late 19th century. There is one new addition to the rear of the building on East Potomac Street that was built in the mid 20th century.




