DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Situated on the south side of East Potomac Street and facing north is a two story, two bay, brick dwelling. The gable end is presented to the north and has a stepped parapet end. The roof is sheet metal and of shed design sloping to the east. The two story porch runs along the east wall while a shallow hip roof covers the main front door in the south wall. This house was built in the 19th century. The windows are six over six double hung sash.


