Description

Washington County National Savings Bank. Two and a half story, four bay Greek Revival brick house with a Flemish Bond facade and stepped parapet ends. Small attic "Eye brow" windows have decorative metal grills. Early 19th century. It is said to date from the time of the establishment of the bank in 1815 and was built as a bank building.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Situated on the south side of West Potomac Street and facing north is a two and one half story, four bay brick building dating from the early 19th century. A tablet on the building gives the date as 1815. The building is painted a slate grey color over Flemish bonding at the front elevation. The walls terminate at the gables with stepped parapet ends which form a pattern with double inside end brick chimneys. Separated from the main two stories by a false cornice are a series of half windows beneath the eaves. They are trimmed with decorative metal grill work. Other windows have six over six pane double hung sashes beneath wide molded wood lintels. The off center entrance is located in the east central bay.
