This small frame house is located on the west side of the alley behind South Conococheague Street, just north of East Church Street. It is a two story, two bay shed roofed structure covered with German siding. Windows have two over two pane sashes with molded flat topped architraves. There is a shed roofed porch extending across the front. The house appears to be in good condition and probably dates from the early 20th century.


