This house, located on the southeast corner of East Salisbury and Artizan Streets has facades on both streets. It has a combination hip and gable roof with the hip joint on the street corner. The house is apparently of log construction and has four bays fronting on East Salisbury Street and five bays on Artizan Street. The building is sheathed with lapped wood siding. The principal facade is that on Artizan Street with a central entrance having an eight panel door. Windows have two over two pane sashes. Large brick chimneys are located inside the gables and at the center of the building.
