Description

Two story, three bay hip-roofed brick Colonial Revival house dating from the early 20th century. It has grouped windows and cast stone trim. The present structure is said to have replaced an old market house and a school. It became a residential building in 1922-23, according to local informants. The school is shown on the 1910 Sanborn Insurance maps.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Located on the south side of East Salisbury Street is this two story hip roofed brick structure dating from the early 20th century. It is a three bay house with all stretcher brickwork. Windows are a combination of multi and single panes and are grouped in pairs of triple sections. The entrance is centrally placed in the facade. It has a wide elliptical fanlight with sidelights flanking the door. An extension which is part of the original construction stretches to the west at the rear of the house.
