DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house is located on the south side of East Salisbury Street and is a two story, three bay tan brick structure dating from the early 20th century. It is a hip roofed building with a large two story semi hexagonal projecting bay with a pedimented gable top. Openings have segmentally arched tops and six over one and eight over one pane sashes. First story windows have large single panes below rectangular transoms. The main entrance is located in the second bay from the east end and includes a transom and sidelights surrounding the door.
