DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This structure located on the south side of W. Salisbury Street is a two story, three bay addition to the back of WA-WIL-017, probably of frame construction. Its front surface is covered with composition siding while its exposed west side displays German siding. Windows have single pane double hung sashes with flat topped architraves of the 20th century. While at the second story, the building has two bays, at its first story, there are three bays: two doors flanking a window. The exterior finishes of this house date from the 20th century. The structure could, however, be older.
