This house, located on the south side of West Salisbury Street is a two story, three bay brick building probably dating from the late 18th or early 19th century. Its walls have been painted bright red. The front elevation displays Flemish bond brick work with flat arches above the openings. Windows have modern single pane sashes within old moderately wide frames. The main entrance is located in the west bay of the front elevation. The roof is covered with standing seam sheet metal. There is a large inside end chimney at the east gable. A small Victorian entrance porch shelters the door.
