DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame house dating from the early 20th century is located on the south side of West Salisbury Street. Sheathed with German siding, it is a two story, three bay structure with a central cross gable. Windows have single pane sashes trimmed with flat topped architraves. A small palladian type window is located in the cross gable. The main entrance is in the center bay. Corbeled brick chimneys are located inside the gable ends.
