This house is located on the east side of Artizan Street facing west. It is a two story, three bay hip roofed brick structure, painted red. It dates from the early 20th century. Windows have single pane sashes with segmentally arched heads. There is a hip roofed dormer in the front slope of the roof. The main entrance is located in the north bay of the front elevation. A porch with square pillars extends across the front.
