DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house is located on the northeast corner of Artizan and Salisbury Streets with its principal facade facing west. It is a two story, three bay L-shaped brick house with common bond walls. Windows have segmentally arched heads formed by a double row of header bricks. A round arched window is located in the projecting gable at the attic level. There are single pane sashes at most front windows, grouped in pairs separated by mullions. The main entrance is located in the recessed portion of the ell. Its walls have been sandblasted. The house would appear to date from the early 20th century.


