DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Situated on the east side of North Artizan Street facing west is a one and one half story frame or log, four bay, double house. It was built in two parts, but no determination could be quickly made as to original and addition sections. The south end has a window, door combination while the north is door, window. The north section also has two wall dormers on the second story. The roof is standing seam sheet metal, the walls stuccoed, the foundation limestone, and the windows are one over one on the first story. This was probably built in the mid 19th century. There is a simple two bay over the two doors shed roof front porch.


