This house, located on the west side of North Artizan Street is an early 20th century one and a half story bungalow. Set on a large wooded lot and built of brick, it is large for a bungalow. The basic structure consists of three bays beneath a hipped roof. This is extended by a large cross gable, dormers and a deep overhanging porch. A brick chimney rises from near the center of the hipped roof. The house is in excellent condition.


