DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house, located on the west side of North Artizan Street is a two story, three bay frame structure inspired by the Gothic Cottage Style. Its walls are covered with asbestos shingle siding. Centered in the front elevation is a cross gable with a window head with a round arch. Windows have single pane double hung sashes. Those at the first story are quite large in size. The main entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation. A porch extends across the front of the house. There is an ell extension to the rear. Brick chimneys are located inside the end walls.

The house would appear to date from the late 19th century and it is in good condition.
