DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house, located on the west side of North Artizan Street is a two story, four bay double residence. It would appear to date from about 1900. Windows have segmentally arched heads with corbeled brick trim at the front elevation. They have single pane sashes and shutters. Entrances are located in the north and south end bays at the front wall. Although each entrance appears to have had a transom they are now covered over. Brick chimneys are located inside the end walls. There is a brick extension to the rear which appears to be part of the original construction.
