This house, located on the west side of North Artizan Street is a two and one half story, three bay frame house resting on high stone foundations. The surface of the house is covered with asbestos shingle siding. Windows have two over two pane sashes. The main entrance is located in the south end bay of the front wall. It includes a transom above the door. The major architectural feature at the front of the house is a two bay Victorian entrance porch with brackets, pendants and a latticework base. The house is in good condition.




