This house, located on the west side of South Artizan Street is a two story, three bay log structure covered with asbestos shingle siding. It would appear to date from the mid 19th century. Windows have six over one pane sashes with plain flat architraves. There are only two bays at the second story level. The main entrance is located in the central bay. It does not have a transom. The roof is covered with sheet metal. The house appears to be in good condition.
