DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house, located on the south side of East Frederick Street is a one story, three bay gable front structure probably dating from the early 20th century. The house has been covered with aluminum siding. Windows have single pane sashes with plain architraves. Several windows are doubled, separated by wood mullions. Shed dormers extend from the roof. The main entrance is centered in the front elevation. A shed roofed entrance porch is supported with thick square posts. Straight brackets along the eaves suggest Eastlake stylistic influence. The house is in good condition.
