DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house, located on the south side of East Frederick Street, is a one and a half story, two bay frame structure dating from the early 20th century. It is covered with German siding and has double three over one light windows separated by wood mullions. There is one triple set of windows at the first story front. A shed roofed dormer extends across the front of the house and there is a deep porch supported by thick square posts resting on brick piers. The main entrance is located in the east bay of the front elevation. A small brick chimney with a corbel at its top extends from the roof peak near its center. According to residents of this street, this house was built in 1924.
