DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house, located on the south side of East Frederick Street, is a two story, four bay L-shaped frame structure covered with aluminum siding. Although the house is simple, it shows influence of the Gothic Style. It has a projecting gable front with two over two pane windows. Those at the first story are quite long. The main entrance is in the recessed portion of the front elevation, in the second bay from the east end. There is a wrap around front porch with a hipped roof. It is supported by turned posts. The house is in excellent condition and would appear to date from the early 20th century.
