This house, located on the east side of South Vermont Street is a two story, three bay frame structure covered with aluminum siding. It probably dates from the early 20th century. Windows have two over two pane sashes and aluminum shutters. There are only two bays at the second story level. The main entrance is located in the central bay offset slightly to the north. There is a modern pedimented entrance porch trimmed with a plastic eagle. The roof is covered with corrugated sheet metal. The house appears to be in excellent condition.
