DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house, located on the east side of South Vermont Street is a two and one half story, three bay frame building covered with asbestos shingle siding. Windows have two over two and single pane sashes. The main entrance is located in the central bay and has a narrow transom. The roof is covered with sheet metal. Small brick chimneys with corbeled tops rise from inside the end walls. A hip roofed porch supported by square wood posts extends across the front of the house. The building rests on high stone foundations. The house is in good condition and probably dates from the early 20th century.
