DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house located on the east side of South Vermont Street is a one and a half story, three bay log structure covered with composition siding. First story windows have single pane double hung sashes. Those at the upper half story have three over three light sashes. The main entrance is located in the central bay but offset slightly to the south. There is no transom. The roof is covered with standing seam sheet metal. A brick chimney is located near the center of the house. The building appears to be in fair condition and probably dates from the late 19th century.
