This house, located on the east side of South Vermont Street is a two story, three bay frame structure covered with German siding. Windows have two over two pane sashes. A semi-hexagonal projecting bay extends from the first story at the north end of the front wall. The main entrance is located in the central bay and includes a transom. A brick chimney with corbeling at its top rises from the center of the house. The building is in good condition and probably dates from the early 20th century.
