DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This gable front frame house located on the east side of South Vermont Street is attached to its neighbors on either side. It is a two and one half story, three bay structure covered with asbestos shingle siding. It appears to have been built as part of a trio with the two Italianate buildings on either side. Windows have six over six pane sashes. The main entrance is located in the north bay of the front elevation. Returns at the eaves are formed by extensions of the eaves and cornices of the buildings on either side. The shed roofed porch across the front is modern. The house dates from the late 19th century and appears to be in excellent condition.




