DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house, located on the east side of South Vermont Street, is a one and a half story, four bay log structure covered with aluminum siding. Its appearance suggests that it may date from the late 18th century. Windows at the front elevation have two over two pane sashes, double hung, which are replacements. The windows have modern shutters. The main entrance is located off center in the third bay from the north end. It has wide framing and includes a transom. There is a small late 19th century entrance porch with a hipped roof. The roof is covered with standing seam sheet metal. An interior chimney of brick rises from the roof peak, offset slightly to the south. The house appears to be in good condition.






Sanborn Map, 1929
