Windows have two over two pane sashes and are trimmed with modern shutters. The main entrance is located in the north bay of the front wall. It includes a transom. Chimneys are located inside the east or front wall and at the interior of the house. They are of brick construction. Roofing material are modern. This house may date from the mid 19th century. It is in good condition.


