DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house, located on the west side of South Vermont Street is a one story, three bay log structure probably dating from the late 18th or early 19th century. It appears to be covered with original or early siding, regular lapped boards at the front with wider, random lapped wood at the side and rear walls. Windows have two over two pane sashes which are not original. The main entrance is located in the north end bay of the front elevation. The door includes a transom. The roof is covered with sheet metal. The house appears to be in good condition.


