This house, located on the west side of South Vermont Street is a two story, four bay aluminum sided log structure which probably dates from the late 18th or early 19th century. Windows have two over two pane sashes with arched upper panes. They are not original and have been trimmed with modern decorative shutters. There are two front entrances, in the second and fourth bays from the south end. The roof is covered with sheet metal. A large brick chimney extends from inside the north end wall. A hip roofed porch supported by chamfered posts extends across the front. The house appears to be in good condition.
