This house on the west side of South Vermont Street is a two story, three bay brick structure, probably dating from the late 19th century. It is painted red. Openings have segmentally arched heads. There are single pane sashes which probably are not original. The main entrance is located in the north end bay. There is a hip roofed entrance porch supported by turned posts. A small brick chimney rises from inside the south end wall. The house appears to be in good condition.


