DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house, located on the southwest corner of West Salisbury and South Vermont Streets is a two story, five bay log structure covered with compositon siding and asbestos shingles. It probably dates from the late 18th or early 19th century. Windows have two over two pane sashes which are not original. The openings are evenly spaced in the walls. There are two entrances, one in the central bay and a second one to its south. Both have transoms. The roof is covered with sheet metal. A brick chimney extends from inside the north end wall. There is a smaller brick flue outside the south end. A two story ell extends to the rear.
