DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This small log house is located on the east side of North Vermont Street. It is a one and a half story, three bay structure covered with aluminum siding. Windows have modern single pane sashes. The entrance is located in the south end bay of the front elevation. The roofing material is standing seam sheet metal. A brick chimney extends from inside the north end wall. The house appears to be in good condition and probably dates from the very early 19th century.


