DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The G. C. Twilley House is located on the south side of Water Street, one-half block west of the intersection of Main and Water Streets in Sharptown, Maryland. It is a two and a half story frame house of the late nineteenth century with a gable roofed main block oriented west. The three-bay west elevation has a one-story shed roofed porch with turned columns and balustrade. The gable end facing Water Street is a polygonal bay with patterned shingles in the gable and a perforated sunburst gable ornament. A two and half story extension intersects the main block on the east elevation, and a one-story addition of a later date adjoins the south. Interior end chimneys project through the roof of the main section which also has a widow's walk of possibly modern vintage. A third small chimney breaks through the roof at the intersection of the main and east gables. The exterior is covered in weatherboards and the original sash has been replaced by modern storm windows.



The 1877 Atlases and Other Early Maps of the Eastern Shore of Maryland.


