Constructed in 1928, the building at 1102 Camden Avenue displays features of the Dutch Colonial style of architecture, a common style of the early to mid-twentieth century. The side gambrel roof, like this house, was most prevalent during the 1920s and 1930s. It is located across Camden Avenue from Salisbury State University which originated in the same period. The residential structures along Camden date from the 1920s and 1930s with some recent infill construction. Based on very limited information, the significance of 1102 Camden Avenue has not been demonstrated and the Trust concurred that this common building type is not eligible. Demolition has occurred.




