Like many of the old buildings of the back areas of the Eastern Shore, the Lester Richardson House is a small one-story frame dwelling standing on a brick foundation. It appears to have been constructed as a single room dwelling with loft and later enlarged by the addition of another single room and loft. Each section has a central door flanked by 2 windows (2/2 sash) and 2 windows flanking the fireplace or chimney on the gable end. Two small casements flank the chimney in the loft. To the rear of what appears to be the earlier part is a leanto porch, partially enclosed.

 enclosed.


