The house at 605 W. Main Street in Salisbury, Maryland is located outside of the boundaries of the Salisbury Historic District and is not individually eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

The two-story, three-bay, central-passage frame house is set upon a raised brick foundation and is covered with a gable roof. The walls are clad with asbestos shingles and a shed roof porch has been added to the front elevation. Built in the late 19th century, the house is typical of the vernacular domestic building of the period and lacks the architectural distinction and integrity necessary to qualify it for listing on the National Register under Criterion C. The property is not known to have any associations with persons or events significant to our past, and is thus not eligible under Criteria A or B.




