Based on available information the structure at 409 Truitt St., Salisbury, Md., does not meet the National Register Criteria for individual listing and is not located within a National Register Historic District. This simple two story, gable ended Cape Cod cottage with symmetrical dormers and projecting porch with Colonial Revival detailing at the entrance is typical of residential structures built from 1915 to 1940. It is not likely to be eligible under Criterion C. It is not known to have been associated with any significant event or person and is not located in an identified historic district.


