The Lillian Smith House does not appear to meet the National Register Criteria for individual listing or for district nomination. The frame "I" house appears to date to the turn-of-the century and has undergone some exterior alteration, including the applicaion of asbestos shingles. It is similar to numerous houses throughout the Eastern Shore and does not appear to be a particularly significant example of the type. The property is not known to be associated with any event or persons significant in history. It is located well outside the Quantico Historic District.


