Forest Grove Old School Baptist Church, located in a stand of mature oaks, is a well-preserved frame building that survives with few alterations since its construction during the late year of the nineteenth century. The rectangular frame structure, supported on a low brick foundation, is sheathed with plain weatherboards, and it is covered with a steeply pitched gable roof. Distinctive to the structure is the symmetrical placement of two front doors on its main facade. The two doorways point to the conservative attitude of the Baptist congregation that dictated separation of the sexes in the entrance and exit of the building.

The Forest Grove Old School Baptist Church stands on the northwest corner of the intersection of Forest Grove Road and Longridge Road south of Parsonsburg, Wicomico County, Maryland. The single-story frame church faces south with the gable roof oriented on a north/south axis.

Dating to 1897, the single-story gable-front frame church is supported by a continuous brick foundation, and the exterior is clad with plain weatherboards painted white. The steeply pitched roof is sheathed with asphalt shingles. The church lot is shaded by a mature stand of oak trees.

The south gable end is a symmetrical two-bay facade with a pair of identical entrances evenly placed along the wall surface. Six-panel doors are topped by colored glass transoms. Each entrance is framed by a plain surround. A decorative Victorian molding stretches across each door lintel. Fixed between the two doors is a wooden plaque painted with the name of the church and the dates, 1886 and 1897. The gable end of the church is plain aside from an extended eave which return at the base of the roof.

The east and west sides of the church are defined by a symmetrical fenestration with three shuttered window openings. The shutters are louvered. Stretching across the base of the roof is a boxed cornice trimmed with bed and crown moldings. Piercing each side are metal stove pipes.

The north (rear) elevation is distinguished by a shorter single story apse covered by a gable roof. The roof is trimmed with extended eaves that return like the main block. Smaller louvered shutter openings pierce each side of the apse. A rear entrance marks the northwest corner of the main block, which is served by a handicapped ramp.

The interior was not seen.


