Nineteenth century

The only nineteenth-century structure to mark what was once Hayes Landing is a circular fieldstone lime kiln, the only structure of its type to survive on the lower Eastern Shore. Surrounded by marsh and the slightly higher ground of Newport farm, the rubble fieldstone kiln stands within a hundred feet of Newport Creek which eventually feeds into Chincoteague Bay. Not only was lime shipped from this point during the nineteenth century, but the 1877 Worcester county atlas locates granaries near the landing for the storage and shipment of wheat as well.

Prepare both a summary paragraph and a general description of the resource and its various elements as it exists today.

The old lime kiln stands on the northeast side of Hayes Landing Road southeast of Berlin, Worcester County, Maryland. The fieldstone structure stands within a short distance of Newport Creek, which empties into Newport Bay and then Chincoteague Bay.

The circular, rubble fieldstone structure is approximately fifteen feet across and twenty feet high with a small arched opening in the south arc of the structure. There are a number of hook shaped metal rods that extend from the stone wall in a number random places. The brick arch has been rebuilt, and the rubble fieldstone walls have been repointed. Original mortar is easily discernable from the new mortar. The small arched opening provides access to the interior of the structure, which is lined with brick, and forms a conical shaped base. Long rectangular tiles set on end comprise the base of the cone which is filled with brick bats.

The old lime kiln on Hayes Landing Road maintains its historic setting near Newport Creek. The twenty foot tall, circular, rubble fieldstone structure stands within twenty yards of the water and at the edge of the paved road that led to the landing. Surrounding the lime kiln to the north and east is marsh or the higher ground of Newport farm. This lime kiln is the only structure of its type that is known to survive on the lower Eastern Shore, and it represents a significant nineteenth-century process of lime production formerly vital to the region.







 Berlin Quadrangle, 1967



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
