The old Staton, Whaley, and Price law office is the only extant attorney's office erected as such that remains in the center of Snow Hill. The single-story, hip roofed building was designed with a four-bay principal facade that included two separate entrances that opened into individual offices. Built around 1900, the exterior the exterior of the stretcher bond brick structure has not changed significantly and contributes to the turn of the century character of Pearl Street. The hip roof is an interesting contrast as well to the flat roofed buildings to each side.

The old Staton, Whaley, and Price law office, currently housing the firm of Coates, Coates, and Coates, stands at 110-112 Pearl Street in the heart of Snow Hill, Worcester County, Maryland. The single-story, four-bay brick building faces southwest.

Built around the turn of the twentieth century, the single-story, stretcher bond brick law office is covered by steeply pitched, asphalt shingle hip roof.

The southwest (main) facade is an asymmetrical four-bay elevation of alternating doors and windows. The northernmost bay is filled with a five-panel door that features a single-pane transom, a segmental brick arch, and a marble sill. The second bay from the north is marked by a large round arched window opening filled with a pair of single-pane sash windows. The upper part of the opening is distinguished by an arched window with radiating muntins, and the round curve to the window opening is accented with a raised brick course. The third bay from the north is filled by another five-panel door, and the fourth bay is defined by an identical rounded arch window. Fixed beneath each window is a small segmental arch cellar opening, and stretching across at the base of the roof is a dentiled cornice.

The sides of the law office are covered by adjacent buildings, and the interior was not seen.

The old Staton, Whaley, and Price law office is the only surviving attorney's office erected for that purpose that survives in the center of Snow Hill. The single-story, four-bay structure allowed for two individual offices with separate doors and large arched windows. Built around the turn of the twentieth century, the exterior of the hip roofed structure has not changed significantly with original door and window openings filled with period doors and windows sash. Each opening is accented with raised brick courses. A dentiled cornice finishes the eave.





