<p>The Doty House stands in an ample yard behind a crenelated masonry wall. Its two bay gable faces the street. One is an entrance with wooden trellis supported and the other a two-story bay window. The house has a few elements of the Italianate style, but the pilasters appear more Greek Revival. It's a very deep house, with a one-story wing.
