Like the Evans House, its exterior walls are covered with cypress shingles and also it is similar in plan, having three small rooms in a row. The exterior elevation differs in that there are three different roof lines, apparently the result of three periods of building. The interior is very plain and is either the product of a late eighteenth or early nineteenth century owner. In form, it is similar to a house with hyphen and kitchen. A porch extends across the east facade of the latter two portions. With the exception of the chimney placement, it is very similar to Ralph Boston Farm, a house which is still occupied.</p>
