The upper part is rebuilt with new brick. In the gable are two windows with six over six sash and one door on first story, access to which is by several concrete steps. The other sides of this section are built of frame covered with asbestos shingle. There are two windows with nine over six sash on each side. The original box cornice is in place as are three of the curved end-boards, typical of Worcester County houses.</p> <p>On the northeast side is a two-bay wing of the late nineteenth century with four over four sash, asbestos siding,</p>	2.
