It is a Federal frame house built on a brick foundation. It has three parts: the first being a three-bay-long by two-bay-deep, two-story section. The entrance is located on the southern side of the three bays. On the northern side is a tall brick chimney in need of some repair. South of this section is a two-bay, one-and-a-half-story section with a single dormer on its east facade. To the rear of these two sections is a small screened porch with Victorian jigsaw arches not unlike [Berley?] cottage in Berlin. The entire structure is covered with white aluminum siding with green plastic shutters.
