The house at 9732 Hotel ~~Line~~ Road is a two-story front gable frame dwelling erected in the first decades of this century. The dwelling has suffered from the addition of a front porch and deck, asbestos siding and asphalt shingles and lacks the architectural distinction necessary to qualify it for individual listing in the National Register of Historic Places. Further research is necessary to determine whether this resource is located in a National Register-eligible historic district.


